

CHAPTER 10

COMMUNITY SERVICE

10-1 REQUIRED HOURS

- A. Cadets are expected to participate in community service events and hours accumulated count towards quarterly promotions and honor flight points.
- B. Cadets who reach 15 hours at any time during the school year (it does not have to be in a quarter) will be awarded the Service Ribbon. These hours must be from AFJROTC events.

10-2 COMMUNITY SERVICE CREDIT

Only AFJROTC activities and events are credited for community service.

10-3 PROJECT OFFICERS

- A. Every AFJROTC sponsored community service project will have an AFJROTC 3 or 4 cadet assigned as the project officer. The project officer will be responsible for the planning and supervision of the activity. Large events may have more than one cadet assigned as a project officer.
- B. Before the activity, the project officer will complete the Project Officer Activity Report.

After the activity is completed, the project officer will complete the Project Officer After-Action Report.
